Discussion questions for Vireo users in attendance

- What has been your process for managing your migration and upgrade into Vireo
 4?
 - Texas Tech schedule shifts due to mitigating factors at TTU (large cohort, Pandemic, etc); hard to transition mid-semester; looking to move ahead this summer

- Committee member names (12K!) different variations, data needed cleaned up
 - Vireo 3 students entered free-form committee member names in that field; Frank developed a curation tool from V3 to 4
- Internal documentation, managing student questions also essential
- Testing between Allison and Shelley
- UTSW-Med in prod since Feb
 - Admin roles reporting issues that become clear when you start digging deep into the software
- Baylor slated for late May
 - Delayed until summer coordinating between current deadlines and other mitigating factors; waiting on grad school to set date for migration
 - What sticks and doesn't stick (customizations)--TIP take screenshots to changes made so you can easily apply them if they don't 'take' when you go into production added to Getting Started in confluence
- What are your concerns about Vireo 4 transitions?
 - Grad school issues potentially
 - General apprehension of change, especially switches in the middle of semester
 - Jon mentioned that student interface isn't that different from Vireo
 3
 - Important to update local documentation maybe share later this summer across institutions (Action: Courtney)
- How do you collaborate between the graduate school and the library?
 - Work together on Vireo, but a little separated typically; Grad school may even be more active in Vireo than the library; repository connection 2-3 times per year, library lets them know about updates; library has prepared for a long time, but not necessarily grad school
 - Training for grad school?
 - Recording of training shared, but will likely meet up and work together on training again
 - UTSW-Med only 3 schools working with library
 - 2 folks in grad
 - 1 in med school
 - 1 in school of health prof
 - In Vireo 4, configured by school, not units within
 - Mapped as much as possible for each group, a session for each walking through steps and changes
 - ACTION: grad school/librarian training and ga session (Courtney)

- TTU grad school/library relationship different from other schools (in fact, there are differences across most TDL-hosted Vireo users)
- Baylor staff changes are another mitigating factor; ideally more than one entity submitting to Vireo rather than DSpace directly
 - Emphasized the importance of grad schools using filters
 - Comment from James Creel: This is a significant issue with Vireo 4 when used by multiple divisions in an institution - It is an area for future development - perhaps built-in filters for certain users.
- Discuss your organizational units in Vireo 4.
 - Baylor will build out structure with 5 colleges; discussed various scenarios that do and do not go through the grad school; focus is on getting grad school up and running, then move to working with the needs of the museum studies group

- TTU Question for group: Are other people using Vireo to create lists/bibliographies for specific reference requests DSpace can't handle?
 - Ref libs with specific/complex dissertation questions that are hard to query in DSpace and Primo; Vireo has filters and view customizations that allow refined search
 - Ex. if a person has published 3 articles then groups as dissertation tricky for DSpace, but easy to see in Vireo
