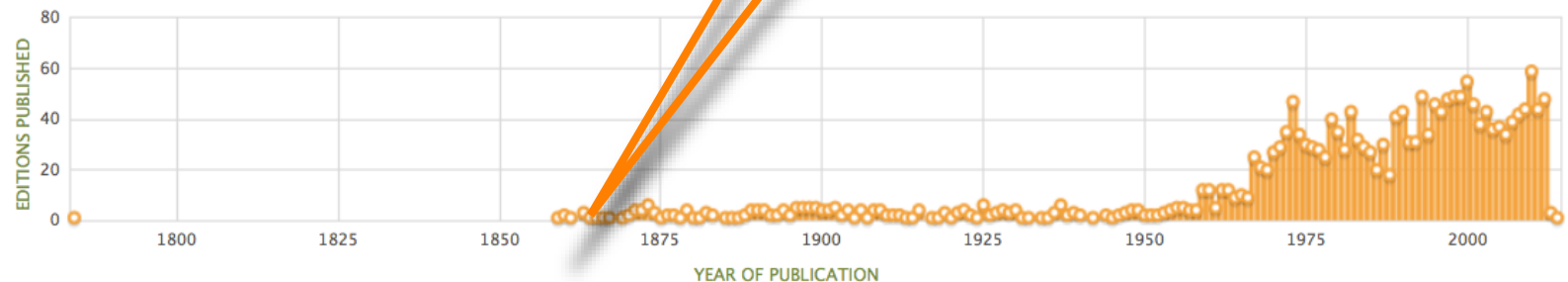

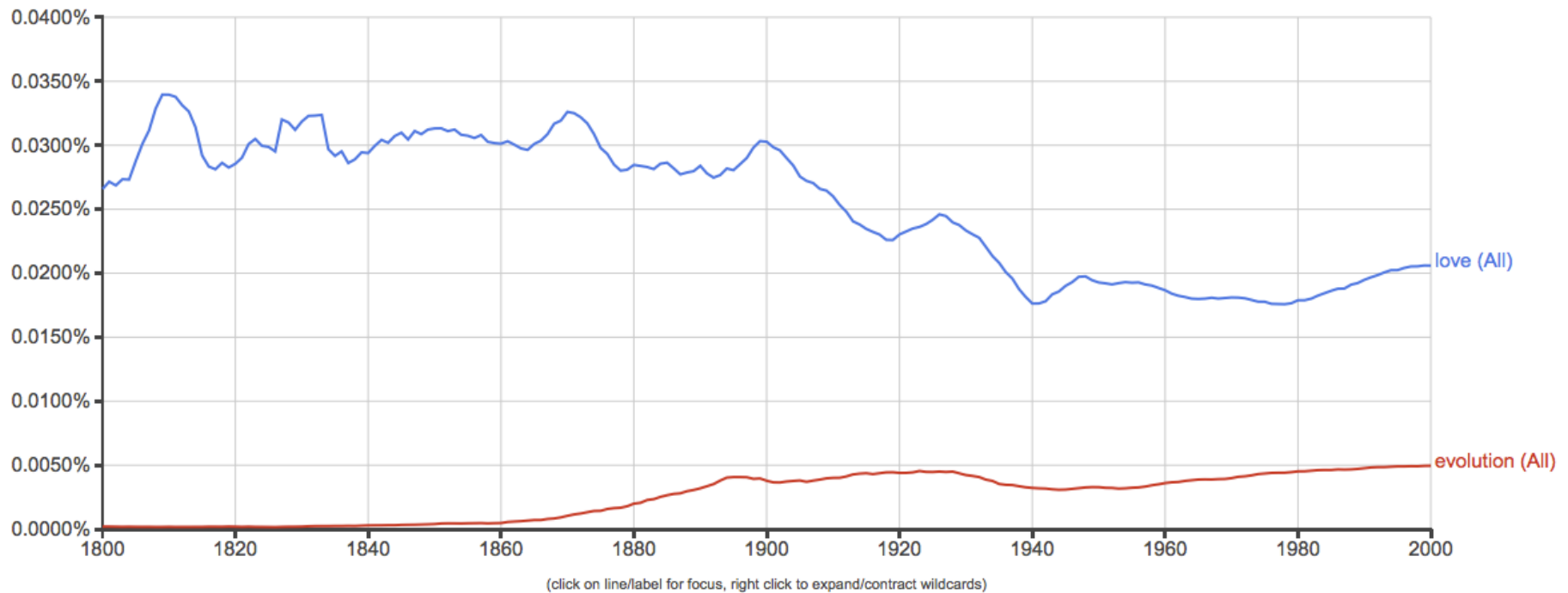

I would preface this review by saying that, 1) I am an avid book collector and reader, and 2) I tend to grope around the house (and my library in particular) side at night after the family are all asleep.

I don't imagine anyone who has grown, or dreams of growing, a personal library not loving this book. It's like sitting and chatting with a wise, engaging friend about a mutual love of books and libraries. Manguel writes the words, I speak them in my head, but they feel like they came right out of my own heart. I won't try to describe these musings in any detail. 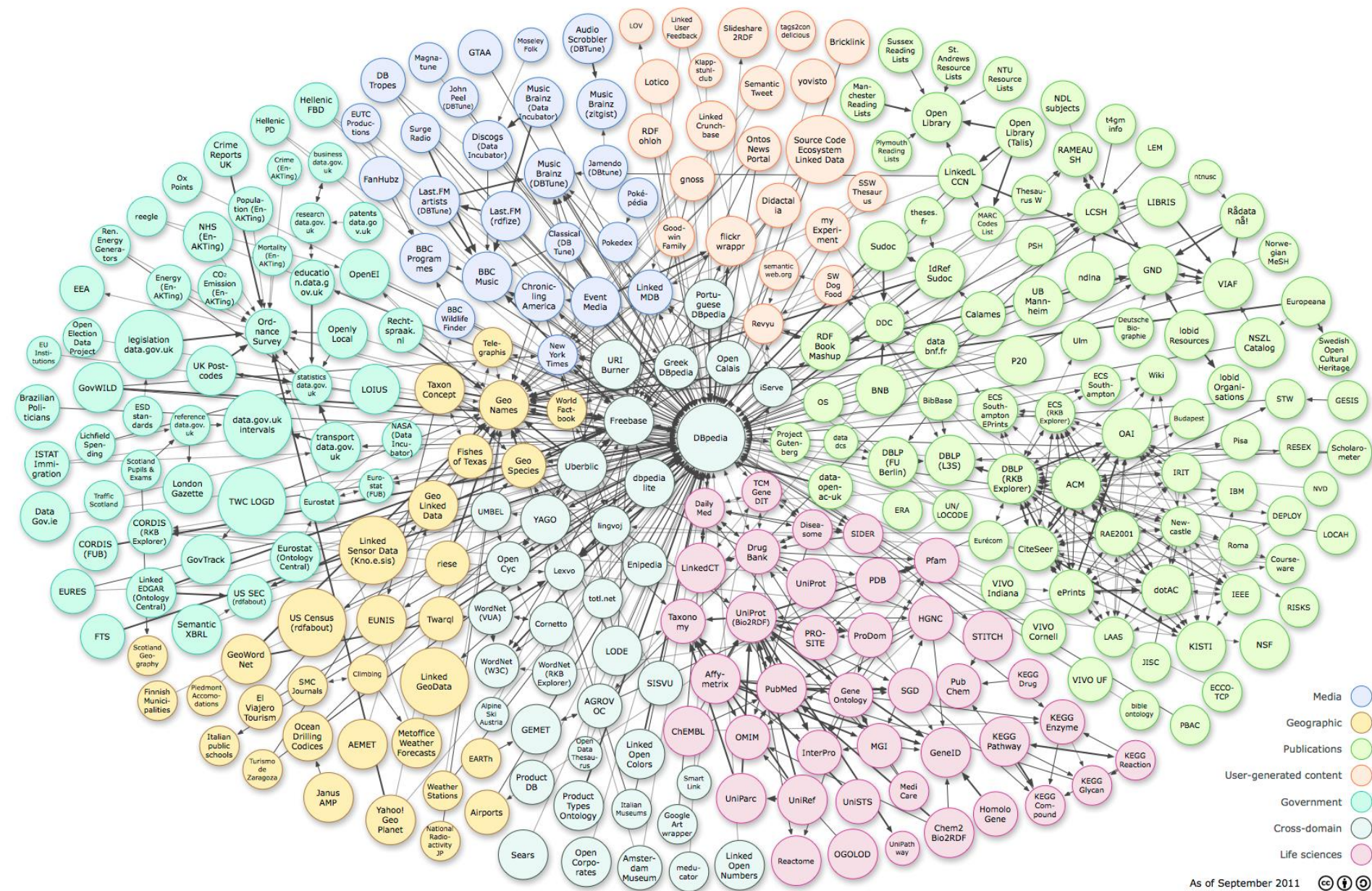

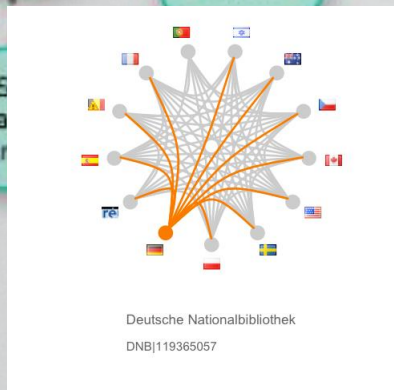

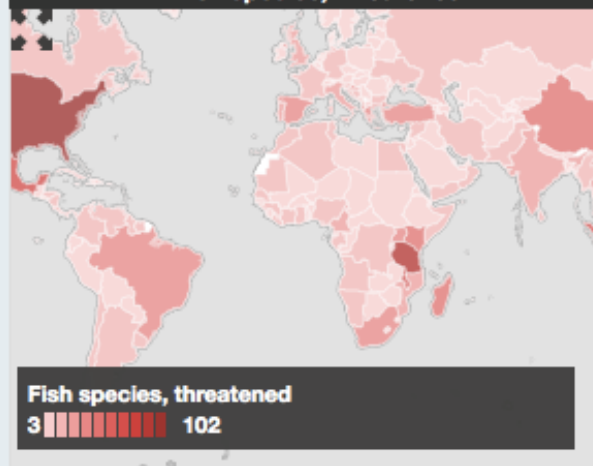

Salmon fisheries in Japan are facing a serious crisis and are being pressed to enact structural reforms. 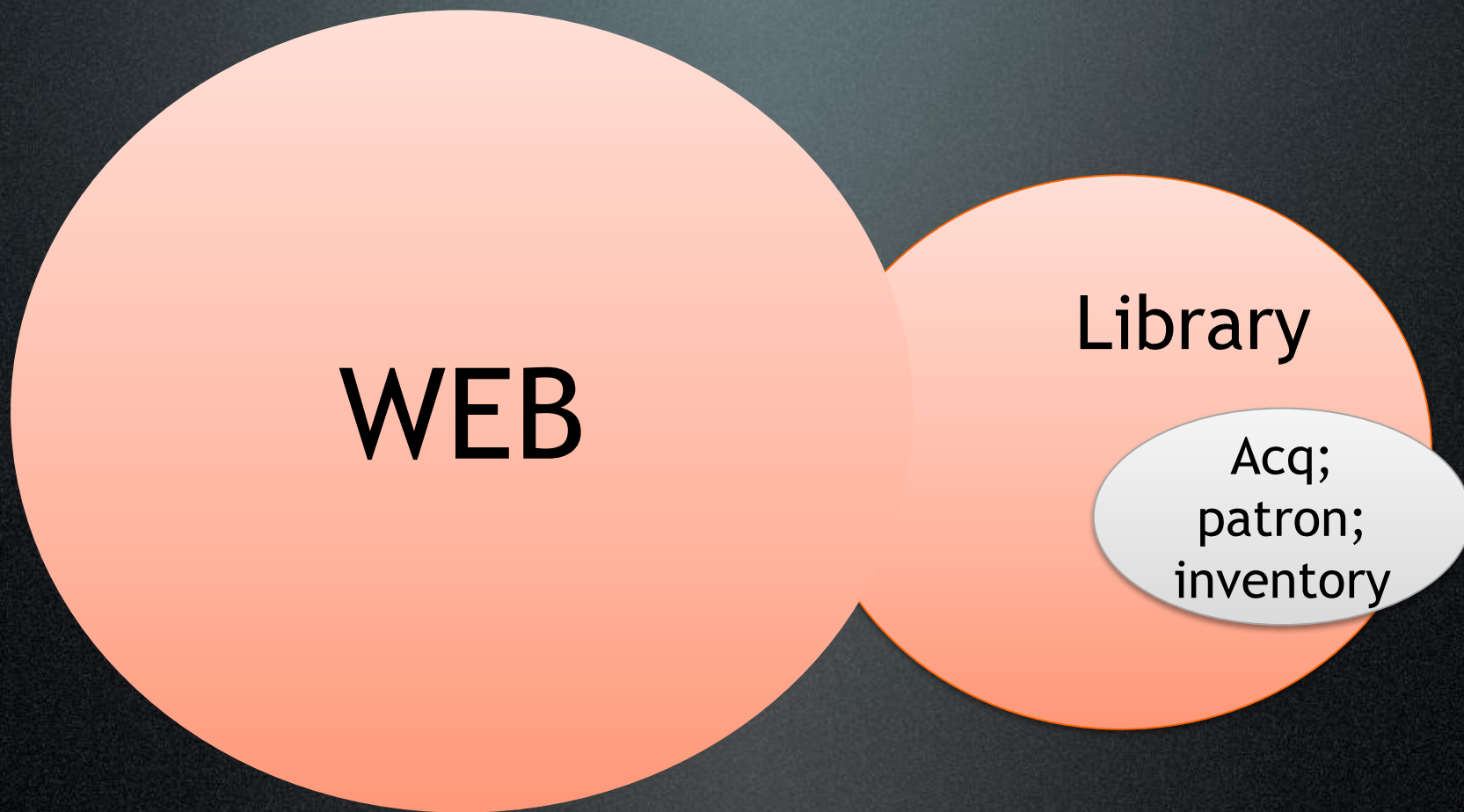
