## A Comparison of Features among ETD Submission Systems

This poster is intended to provide a quick snapshot of features in popular Electronic Thesis and Dissertation submission systems. Current and potential users of ETD systems can see at a glance how their current system matches up to Vireo and Proquest/UMI ETD Administrator. The author examined both the student submission side and staff side of these systems from beginning to end to identify and highlight features that are important for graduate college staff, librarians, and institutional repository staff.

Proquest/UMI ETD Administrator is a free system available for institutions which publish all submissions to UMI Dissertation Publishing.
