Introduction

Many academic libraries maintain significant digital collections of resources, which consist of digitized and/or born digital materials and are considered a part of the academic library's holdings. Despite the increasing prevalence of digital collections, the tasks of librarians working with these collections remain elusive. Digital librarianship, particularly in the context of an academic institution, encompasses a vast array of roles and responsibilities.
