TDL executive director Debra Hanken Kurtz has joined the DPN Business Model Working Group, which has been tasked with creating a formal business plan and establishing a sustainable economic model for the **Digital Preservation Network** (DPN).



The Texas Digital Library is a charter member of DPN, a nationwide effort among academic institutions to develop a geographically distributed, format-independent infrastructure to ensure the preservation of the scholarly record.

Two new TDL-hosted academic journals launched their first issues this summer: the Journal of Analytic Theology and the Texas State Undergraduate Review.

The <u>Journal of Analytic Theology</u>, which came to the TDL through Baylor University Libraries, publishes

articles, book reviews, and book symposia that explore theological and meta-theological topics in a manner that prizes terminological clarity and argumentative rigor.

The <u>Texas State Undergraduate Research Journal</u> is an online, peer-reviewed journal devoted to multidisciplinary undergraduate research at Texas State University.
