Backup Policy

Our data will be stored in three places for all services except DuraCloud:

- 1. EBS volume where the production data resides
- 2. Nightly Snapshots:
 - a. Daily snapshots kept for a month (30 snapshots)
 - b. Monthly snapshots kept for a year (12 snapshots)
- 3. Nightly S3 backups with versioning (Keeps all changes for one year)

- Continued support of Data Management work








Data Management Working Group





- Dataverse Testathon on July 10 at UT Southwestern in Dallas
- All-day testing using requirements matrix developed by the group
- Next steps: finalize recommendation and report
- Convene "implementation working group" to guide data repository implementation (fall 2015)







About Dataverse

Software framework for publishing, citing and preserving research data (open source on github for others to install)

Developed by the Institute for Quantitative Social Science at Harvard University.

Provides incentives for researchers to share:

- Recognition & credit via data citations
- Control over data & branding
- Fulfill Data Management Plan requirements
- Default CC0 Waiver for all uploaded datasets
