




DuraCloud™ @TDL is an ingestion service that helps you move content into various storage providers.

DuraCloud<sup>™</sup> @TDL is *in* production. You can store content in secure storage at 3 existing storage providers.

DuraCloud™ @TDL will also serve as the front-end piece of the **Texas Preservation Node** (part of the Digital Preservation Network).








# Digital Preservation Network

- •TDL, UT Libraries, and TACC continue development of Texas Preservation Node
- •Texas Preservation Node is 1 of 5 eventual nodes in the Digital Preservation Network
- •DPN works on a membership model. Members (including TDL) pay a yearly fee (\$20K) to build the DPN infrastructure and gain access to DPN services.
- •DPN is in its 3<sup>rd</sup> year and is preparing for a "soft launch" in July 2015.







# Preservation Node

**INGESTION** 



TRANSFER/

- •TDL (via DuraCloud™ @TDL) will provide point of ingest to the Texas Preservation Node.
- •The Texas Preservation Node will replicate content to other nodes (3 nodes total).
- •The Texas Preservation Node will hold content replicated from other DPN nodes.





# DPN "soft launch" and beyond

- Soft launch ≠ full production.
- During the soft launch (starting in July 2015), TDL will work with TDL members who are also DPN members to ingest and replicate content in DPN.
- •When in full production (2016), TDL members will have access to DPN storage under TDL's DPN membership.
- Only TDL members will be able to use the Texas Preservation Node, at least initially.
- TDL members will pay a per TB fee for content they choose to put in DPN, just as they do for other DuraCloud™ @TDL storage locations.





# Data Management Working Group

- Evaluating platforms for data management services
- Developed several researcher use cases => rubric for evaluation
- Concluding evaluations and making recommendation for consortial service in fall 2015
- Planning for implementation working group of data management service
